As per Government directives with regard to Ease of Doing Business (EODB), with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2021, all applications for issuance of Fire Safety Recommendation (FSR) in respect of all commercial buildings and G+V and above residential buildings as well as other vulnerable buildings under the jurisdiction of Kolkata Municipal Corporation (Borough I to Borough XVI) are required to be processed only through Common Application Form (CAF) in respect of Construction Permit for Online Sanction of Building Plan under Section 393A of KMC Act, 1980.

2. In view of the above, application submitted on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021 on our online portal edistrict.wb.gov.in/PACE will not be entertained.
